She will then have the children estimate how many objects she has. After counting she will see who's guess came the closest.

Motor

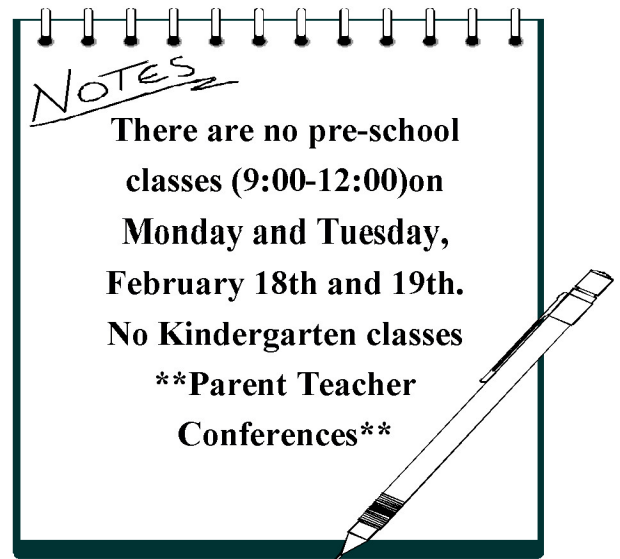
