
Math: Our math focus will be on measurement. Students will continue learning how to measure in nonstandard units (hands, feet, paper clips etc.)
Meanwhile, work will continue with telling time, fractions, and using greater than and less than symbols. The boys and girls will use dominoes to help us with adding and subtracting numbers and rote counting activities with help us review our numbers 1-100. There will also be time to do a graphing activity and work on positional objects as well.

<u>Science</u>: Let's think Spring!! Our class will learn all about the season of Spring and the changes that it brings. We will discuss how the days grow longer and the weather gets warmer, with a lot of rain and stormy weather.

<u>Social Studies:</u> We will be learning how a farm works and the importance of the farm animals and the farmer. The boys and girls will learn about farm machinery and about crops that are grown on a farm. We will discuss a variety of food we can make from those crops.

Art: Look for some fun crafts that remind us of Spring!

The pre-K class will explore all about the farm the next two weeks! The will hear stories, sings songs, play farm at our theme table and of course make farm animal sounds! For concept the children will practice putting number 1-20 in order, play the game tell me the missing number that's hiding and counting 1-100. In language we will be practicing all our story words and focus on our new story number 9 Weeping Willow.
