## **Craft and Writing**

The children will be making community helper hats and other crafts related to our theme. They will also write about the community helper they wish to be when they grow up.

## **Math & Science**

The children will learn about the half dollar, and also learn how to count coins. The \$1.00, \$5.00, \$10.00, and \$20.00 bills and word problems will be the new highlighted math concepts for the next 2 weeks.

## **Language**

The *magic e* and *two vowel rule* will be introduced. *Magic e* tells the vowel in front of it to say its name and not its sound. The *two vowel rule* takes place when two vowels go walking and the first one does the talking.

## **Accelerated Pre K**

Reading Words: is, funny, Funny, Down, down, Fall, fall, He, likes, Stop, stop, too, work, Work.

Subtraction up to 10 telling time by the half hour, and fractions will be our math review.

Long/short vowels and build a word will be the phonics review for the next two weeks.
