## Language:

For our theme of mammals we will learn what they are, how they live, what they eat and which ones can live in homes as pets. The children may bring in toys, books and pictures each day for this two week theme. Our daily review will consist of letter $\mathrm{Aa}-\mathrm{Zz}$, phonics, stories 1-10 and rhyming words. We will also play letter bingo and musical letters to help reinforce our letters and phonics.

## Craft \& Writing:

Over the next two weeks the children will be working on papers and projects to reinforce our theme of mammals. We will work on papers to introduce the shape of hexagon along with papers that will help with their positional words; above, below, on, inside, beside and under. The children will also work on papers to help review their numbers, patterning skills and sequencing skills.

## Concept:

For the next two weeks in Concept we will continue to work on number concept. We will also play what's missing; using our tactile bag and work on compare and contrast activities. We will start practicing counting by 2's and continue practicing tying shoes. The children will be working on new jobs that will reinforce our theme of mammals.

## Motor:

The tumbling mat and the tunnel will be a part of the first obstacle course. The rocking boat and cardboard blocks will be part of the second obstacle course. We will also play hot potato, Simon Says and hop scotch, along with using bean bags to help us review numbers 20-30.
