Miss Sam has more farm fun planned. The letters Ss and Tt will be reviewed, as well as a tracing worksheet. We will also do a fun farm themed craft.

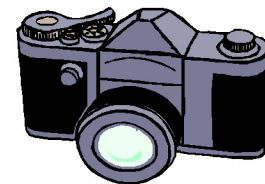
