Theme: Nursery Rhymes

Language Arts:

The children will learn several nursery rhymes including: Jack and Jill, Mary Had a Little Lamb, Baa Baa Black Sheep, and Humpty Dumpty. Books, flannel boards and stories, and finger plays will help us explore these nursery rhymes. We'll also have fun with the finger plays Pat-a-Cake and Five Little Piggies. We will also review all of our letters, numbers, colors, and shapes that have been introduced so far this year.

Concept:

We will continue to review our colors and shapes, by sorting them appropriately. The alphabet bucket Aa and number buckets 1 and 2, will help reinforce these previous introductions. For science. The children will be

discussing, and looking for fall changes. To enhance our theme, the children will jump over a pretend candlestick, as we sing Jack be nimble, Jack be quick!

Motor: The children will be moving indoors and out! We will be playing some of the children's favorite game, Body Parts and Follow the Directions. We'll also test our skills by walking on the balance beam, block bowling, and using the ball and wand. We will also enjoy the playground outdoors!

Craft and Writing:

The children will be painting, coloring, and creating mosaic pieces of some of the nursery rhyme characters we discuss. Our papers will help us review our numbers 1 and 2.

Although we will still be celebrating birthdays and holidays at our school, we are not allowing treats to be sent and passed out at this time. We will provide the children with a special snack and plenty of extra fun activities on these days. Thanks for understanding.
