Theme: Pets

Language Arts:

The children will learn the letters Ee and Ff. Several phonics games will help to introduce these next two letters of the alphabet. The children will be learning animals that can be pets and help people. The children will learn how to care for animals, the sounds they make, and what they look like. We'll be playing veterinarian as we take care of our stuffed animals in the classroom. We will be saying please and thank you, as we share our vet set! In addition, we'll discuss the importance and meaning of our first proverb, do unto others. Lastly, we'll create our own stories dictated by the children. *If you have a pet, please bring in a picture of it.

Concept:

Animals will be taking over our classroom! They will be filling our estimation jars, mystery bag, and shelf jobs!
