Language Arts:

This week, the boys and girls will finish off our first alphabet review with the letters Ww and Xx. Printing practice and phonetic sounds will be reviewed and we will spend a great deal of time stressing the importance of using capital and lowercase letters when needed. Word family practice will continue and the students will make a flip book with words that share the -it word family ending. Our phonics books will focus on beginning and ending sounds.

Science:

This week, we will work on an experiment that teaches the difference between a solid, a liquid, and a gas.

Math:

The boys and girls will continue working on number sequence and rote counting from 1-100. Our math workbooks will focus on greater than and less than, and practice how to place the < and > symbols between numbers.

Social Studies:

We will start a new unit on Native Americans this week and the boys and girls will learn that Native Americans were the first people who lived in our country. We will discover that they lived together in groups called tribes. The children will enjoy learning about the Plains, River, Woodland, and Pueblo Native Americans.
