<u>Language Arts</u>: These weeks ahead your little ghosts and goblins will be learning about Halloween and safety. We will start our week by learning some safety rules for home and school including "Dial 911" and "Stop, Look and Listen." These are finger plays that help us remember what to do to stay safe. The next week we will be hearing Halloween tales such as *The Haunted House That Jack Built* and *Haunted House Haunted Mouse*.

"Stop, look and listen before you cross the street Use your eyes, use your ears and then use your feet."

<u>Concept:</u> Halloween is fast approaching and what fun we will have in our concept class. We will be learning about safety and about sorting and patterning. We have a lot of fun in our water table and going on a ghost hunt. And don't forget watching the seasons change. I hope you are all looking around and enjoying the beautiful colors; I know we are. The concepts "heavy" and "light' will be introduced as well as adding more colors and numbers to our review.

Triangle and rectangle shapes will be introduced to the children. Be sure to look for our Halloween art projects around the classroom, the children are so excited for Halloween!
