Language Arts: Our new season will be the focus this week as we begin a fun unit on Fall. The boys and girls will learn about the many changes in nature that Autumn brings. We will discuss how the cooler weather affects people, animals and plants. Our oral language activity will be a game called "Pick One and Tell Me Why," in which the children must identify a picture of a familiar object and describe its function

Mr. Squirrel Who's that scampering up the tree? carrying acorns 1, 2, 3! It's Mr. Squirrel with a tail so furry, He's getting ready for winter, so don't you worry!

Concept: This week we will be discussing Fall and the changes we are going to start seeing outside. For our science activity we will be going on a nature walk to look and collect signs of Autumn. On our walk the class will search for leaves that will fill or cover different shapes. Then we will count our leaves that are the same size, and graph our results. Our class will also count/estimate how many steps it will take to get to certain objects in the room. We will introduce a new activity, where five children will line up in order holding cards with the number 1-5. Then they will change positions and try to get back into the correct order.

<u>Craft and Writing</u>: Throughout the week the children will be challenged with some pattern papers as well as review papers focusing on concepts introduced thus far. We will also be working on our new numbers 7 and 8.
