Craft & Writing - Our theme this week centers around folk tales. The children will enjoy coloring and painting pictures of some of our most loved stories like "The Little Red Hen and Little Red Riding Hood." We will spend some time working with play dough and shaving cream. Letters Ee and Ff will be introduced to the children and reinforced by mosaicing and fingerpainting. We will continue practicing holding our pencils and begin tracing circle and square shapes.
