Craft and Writing: Fall is here-leaves are changing colors from their bright green to yellow, red and orange. Squirrels are gathering nuts for the Winter and the birds are getting ready to fly South. The boys and girls will be busy in art decorating lots of colorful leaves and making fall pictures to hang up around the room. We will also be learning the letter Bb.

Concept: We will celebrate Fall with many different activities. A new game called the tactile bag will be introduced as well. The children will be shown a variety of objects that I will place inside a bag. The children will take turns picking out an object that I will name with their eyes are closed. This will make them use their sense of touch for recall. We will discuss the changes that happen in Fall and look at pictures that show the seasons changing.
