We will have an active week as we practice our aim with a tossing game and enjoy activities we've already learned with an obstacle course. We will also have outdoor free play if the weather stays nice.

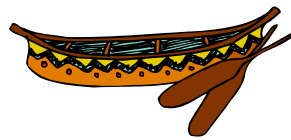
## Concept
