Daycare Weeks: There will be no preschool December 24 - January 1st. School will be open for daycare only. School closes at 3:00 on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. **SCHOOL IS CLOSED on Friday, December 25 and Friday, January 1** to observe the Christmas and New Year holiday. In order to schedule the appropriate amount of staff, we need an accurate count of children attending. Also, due to staffing, your child's regular attending days cannot be switched. If your child does not attend this week, ½ tuition will be due for this week. **If your child only attends preschool (9:00-12:00), then you ARE NOT charged for this week.** If your child does attend daycare week, full tuition will be due. As stated in your tuition policy full tuition is due regardless of absences or holidays. Please turn in your red daycare week response sheet by December 4.
