## Craft & Writing

For the next two weeks, the children will make penguin and winter crafts. The children will also begin printing on lined paper.

### Math & Science

The children will learn to tell time by the hour and half hour. They will also work on recognizing and making simple fractions, including  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 1/3,  $\frac{1}{4}$ , 1/5, and 1/6 and reviewing addition and greater and less than concepts.

### Language Arts

The children will be introduced to "diagraphs". Diagraphs are two letters that together make one sound, such as ch, sh, th, and wh.

The children will also be learning about "CVC" words. Consonant-Vowel-Consonant words.

### Social Studies

We will learn about health and unhealthy eating habits. Our discussions will revolve around the different food groups.
