### Theme- Occupations/Communication

We will be exploring the theme of occupations and communication through experiences provided by this theme. The children will become aware of a great number of occupations. In addition, communication will be studied. The children will learn this can be done through television, radio, computer, and telephone.

## **Language Arts:**

We will focus on blends and diagraphs these weeks. When we talk about blends, we learn that letters keep their sounds. For example, st. When we talk about diagraphs, however, the letters join together to make a new sound. For example, th. Careers will also be discussed and the boys and girls will get to share what they would like to be when they grow up. We will learn that a career is a job that you have when you are an adult. The students will learn the importance of having a career and will become familiar with the term occupation and income. We will also focus on how people learn to do their careers (college or training) and we will discuss many different career opportunities we have today. Dramatic play time will involve hair stylist, post office, and construction occupations.

#### **Social Studies:**

We will make charts of our classroom jobs, what the children would like to be when they grow up, and what jobs our parents have.

#### Science:

The children will learn about telephones/communication, by making sound shakers, and the vibrations sounds cause. We will be making our own telephone.

#### Math:

We will discuss the Junior Achievement Program, where the children will learn about earning and saving money. We will also be rote counting by 2's, 5's, and 10's. The children will also review telling time by the hour, adding 1's and 2's, and simple fractions.

Art: We will be working on Valentine's crafts.
