Language Arts:

We will be introducing the theme of healthy children through fun finger plays including: Good Exercise, Good Foods, and Night, Night Rhyme. The children will also see the stories Night Time, Healthy Habits, and Rise and Shine come to life on our flannel board. The children will also be viewing several surprise picture cards on health.
