We will be completing mid-year evaluations this week, too!

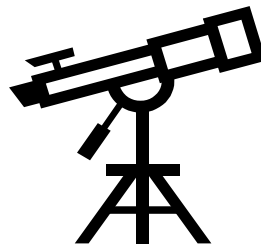
