Art class will keep our fine motor skills working as we use various mediums to create a snowy owl, a polar bear and animal tracks in the snow. We'll keep our bodies moving for gross motor as we dance to music and create animal movements. The children will love doing the iceberg hop again, that was a favorite activity during our winter weeks. For this week's active review, we will feed our arctic animals colorful fish as we sing the "Slippery Fish" song.
