Language Arts: We will review our colors and pay close attention to what color we are wearing this week. The class will build a rainbow and have fun with Party Hats, a couple of our favorite flannel board stories. We will also have a puppet play about the different color fruits.

Art: This week in art we will try to follow directions. We will be coloring, painting, and mosaicing with our beautiful colors. We will also practice cutting with scissors. Can't wait to get our week of color started!

Concept: We will concentrate on all things colorful during the week. The children will have a blast playing color toss. We will also be sorting different colored hands by size. A new review game will be introduced. Different colored hands will be placed on the wall and the children will get a turn to give a "high five" to the color hand that I call out. Also, a new activity introducing the concept of light and dark will be played. I will show different shades of the same color and we will decide which is light and which is dark.

Motor: We are going to play a game where we toss the colored balls in the same color bucket. We love putting different colored balls on top of the parachute and watching them fly as we move the parachute up and down! We'll also reinforce our colors by rolling a cube and standing on the same colored circle that the cube lands on.
