Introduce: Oval & Rhombus
Bit Cards: Shapes

Concept - We will start off our week by sorting our shapes by size. Then we will sort shapes by color and finish the week by matching a big shape to a little one. It will be hard work but we can do it! We will also be getting in shape by exercising - hopefully we can burn some of our energy off!

Language Arts - This week in we will be reviewing shapes. The children will learn a special flannel board story called "Sally the Square" and "Shout for Shapes." We will also look at many picture books, and read about the shapes we see every day.

Craft & Writing - Circle, square, triangle, rectangle, heart and star. Can you guess our topic so far? We will be practicing our pre-writing skills. Shapes! Look around - do you see shapes on everything? We will have fun playing with play-doh and sponge painting our shapes.

Motor: This week we'll practice our throwing skills by throwing a bean bag onto a mat with all the shapes we have learned. When the bean bag lands on a shape we will try to identify it. We'll also practice our aim in block bowling by knocking down an oval and rhombus. We will brush up on our favorite sports during ball play by kicking and shooting into a net and hoop.
