Weeks 30 and 31: March 15-26, 2021 Theme: Mammals (large and small)/The Zoo

Language Arts:

Lions, and tigers, and bears...oh my! The children will discuss mammals we see at the zoo. We will try to name animals that begin with each of the 26 letters of the alphabet. This will be a fun challenge for the group! We will read, and then role play The Three Bears. In addition, we will practice building words. We will also be celebrating St. Patrick's Day on March 17.

Concept:

The children have been doing a wonderful job with the numbers 1-20 that have been introduced. To enhance their skills, the children will be putting these numbers in the correct order. We will also be playing the number line game What Number is Missing? The children will close their eyes as I cover a number, open their eyes, and tell me what

number I'm hiding. In addition to our number fun, the children have been enjoying math games.

Motor:

The children will turn our classroom into a zoo, as they act like different mammals. The children will also enjoy the song Animal Action, which will give the children specific animals to enact. We will be crawling, hopping, and jumping in our classroom zoo.

Craft and Writing:

Many craft projects will take on our mammal theme. Some pattern papers include: connect the dots Aa to Zz, finish the pattern, and circling the pictures that go together. We will continue printing our names, and complete many mammal papers. The children are all doing very well!
