#### Theme:

Ocean Animals

**Introductions:** Simple Addition

#### Language:

Our daily review will continue to be letters Aa-Zz, their phonetic sounds and rhyming words. To help review our letters, phonics and reading words we will be playing letter bingo, the buzzer game and Bozo buckets.

For our theme of ocean animals we will be having new ocean flannel board stories and finger plays to reinforce our theme of the ocean.

### **Craft and Writing:**

This week the children will be working on printing their letters Aa-Zz and numbers 1-20. They will also be working on their color words, shapes and printing their names. To reinforce our theme of ocean animals we will be working on a connect the dots paper and a few ocean animal art projects will be done.

## Concept:

This week we will begin to work on simple addition. We will also work on estimation activities. The children will also work on jobs that will reinforce the numbers 1-20 and letters Aa-Zz. We will also play what's missing, what does not belong and work on greater than and less than.

#### Motor:

In Motor we will be using the balance board and we'll have an obstacle course including the tunnel, balance beam and the hula hoops. The children will also be playing a following directions game and weather permitting we will go outside.
