Weeks 34 and 35: April 19-30, 2021 Theme: The Farm

Language Arts:

We will be reading several selections on our topic, the farm. Our selections will include: Moo, Moo, What are You? and Quack, Quack. We'll also be singing songs such as B-I-N-G-O, and Old MacDonald. The children will get to use our farm hand puppets as we sing these songs. Our flannel board will also help the children to learn some of the characters in our books and songs.
