Language:

We will talk about the farm for three weeks! The children will learn about the animals that live on a farm, machines that are used and what is grown in the fields and many fun facts. We will also sing songs and listen to poems and flannel board stories about the farm.

Craft & Writing:

Over the next few weeks the children will be working on papers and art projects that will reinforce our theme of farm. Concept:
