Introduce: 9 & 10

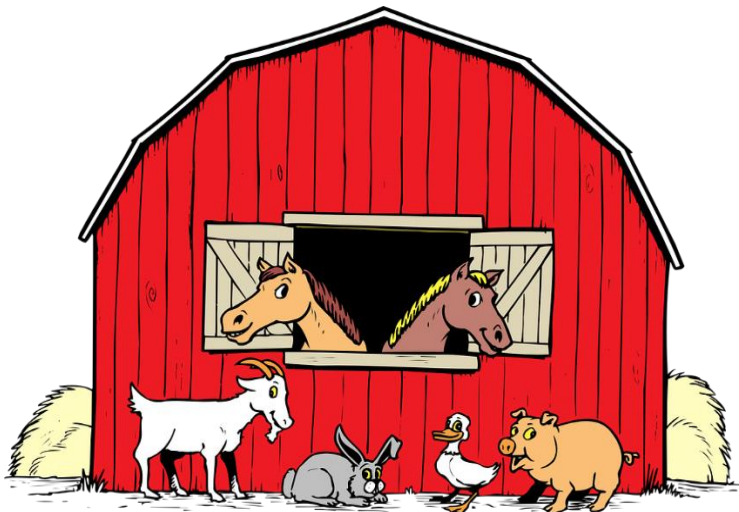
