Theme:
Circus/Carnival

Hello boys and girls of all ages. This week we are going to be learning about the circus and the carnival. We have some fun activities and experiments planned for you this week.

**Monday: Science
Popcorn and Liquid Experiment**

Let's get creative today! We are going to see what happens to popcorn when you put it into different liquids. The liquids we will be using are Coke-a-Cola, milk, water, juice and Crystal Light.

**Tuesday: Technology
Tin Foil Penny Boats**

For our technology activity we will be making tin foil penny boats. To do this we will fold all 4 sides of the foil up to create a boat. Then each child will pick a number between 1-10 and that's how many pennies that they will put in their boat. Then we will use a battery-operated fan to see how far the boat will go and whether it will sink or float.

**Wednesday: Engineering
Roller Coaster Races**

This engineering activity we will use pool noodles, marbles, building blocks and letter review cards. In order to do this, we will have the children place the noodle up against the shelf or wall and then create a barrier around the bottom of the pool noodle with blocks. The children will then take turns dropping their marble down the pool noodle landing on a review letter card. They will then tell us what letter it landed on.

We will have fun making cotton candy puffy paint out of shaving cream, glue and red and blue food coloring. Once we have completed our project, it will look like our very own cotton candy.

Friday: Math
Carnival/Circus Game

We will have lots of fun playing different carnival/circus games such as; bowling, ring toss and using hula hoops and the balance beam. The children will take turns being the ticket collector. They will have to count their tickets and give each ticket collector a certain amount of tickets.
