## LANGUAGE

This week in Language, students will experience some "Old Favorite" activities and stories from the past school year! School is closed on Monday for **Memorial Day**. On Tuesday, our **Nursery Rhymes** theme is back with the *Puppet Play* "Twinkle, Twinkle," the *Listening Activity* "Hickory Dickory Dock," and the *Storybook* "Three Little Kittens." Wednesday we will have fun with **Pets** during activities such as the *Puppet Play* "Oh Where, Oh Where

did my Little Dog Go?," the *Finger Play* "Puppies and Kitties," and the *Storybook* "No, No Jo!." Hungry T-Rex is back in town on Thursday to help review colors and sing songs about **Dinosaurs**. The *Storybook* "Dinosaur Zoom" will also be read. Then on Friday, **Zoo** is the theme of the day! A zoo picture file will be shown and a "Zoo Keeper" activity will be played. The *Puppet Play* "Five Little Monkeys" will be practiced and the *Storybook* "Goodnight Gorilla" will be read.

## CONCEPT

In Concept class this week, students will re-discover some of the fun activities they practiced during our **Nursery Rhymes, Pets, Dinosaur, and Zoo** weeks. On Tuesday, a "Hickory Dickory Dock" *Counting* and *Number Recognition* activity will be reviewed then a "Rub-A-Dub-Dub" bubble activity will be played in the *Water Table*. Wednesday *One-to-One Correspondence* will be practiced during a "Dog

to House" activity and a "Doggie Bone" *Color Matching* game will be played. The students will "Roll the Dice" and *Count out* dinosaurs on Thursday afterwards, dinosaur *Size Seriation* will be practiced. Then on Friday "Real vs. Picture" will be explored using zoo animal figurines and zoo animal pictures. The children will also "Build a Zoo" during a fun Block Center activity!
