Craft an Writing

The children will practice printing the letters Cc, Dd, Ee and Ff when working on their phonics papers. During craft time, the children will make a name collage and a pencil person craft.

Math, Science & Social Studies

The sense of sight and touch will be introduced this week. We will learn about the eyes and different parts of the eye. To help us learn about touch, the children will touch different objects and describe how they feel: rough, smooth, soft, hard, or bumpy. The shapes hexagon, pentagon and color words green, yellow, purple and the numbers 1 thru 10 will be introduced.

Language Arts/Phonics

This week, the letters Cc and Dd will be introduced along with their phonetic sounds. The children will learn about rhyming words that have the same ending sounds.
