Language Arts

Our focus for the next few weeks will be Gg, Hh, Ii, and Jj. We will talk about manners. Manners are kind and thoughtful ways to treat people. Rhyming words will be reviewed this week. A rhyming word is a word that sounds the same and is spelled the same at the end of the word. This is a fun lesson for the children. They love to rhyme!

Craft and Writing

The children will practice printing and tracing the letters Gg, Hh, Ii, Jj when working on phonics papers. We will practice cutting skills and make some fun crafts throughout the week.

Math & Science

Our review of the numbers 1 through 10 continues, focusing on matching numerals to their number words. We will learn about geometric solids. These shapes are fat not flat, and have sides that are called faces.

We will use attribute blocks to sort by color, size and shape.

Over the next two weeks we will learn about the four seasons, and talk about what happens during each season.
