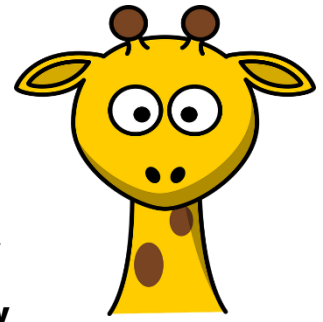


Pre-K Update



Week 30 March 7-11 Theme: Mammals

Introductions: Story #10 – (new words) read, play

Vocabulary: jeopardy – the danger of loss or injury

Knowledge – understanding gained through experience or study

Language Arts - Our theme of mammals will inspire some fun classroom games. We will play an animal memory game and end the week with an animal trivia game. We continue to work on rhyming words and word families, focusing on sounding out the three letter words that create our word families.

Concept - Mrs. Ann has so much information to share about mammals. We will use bears for counting this week. For a science activity we will be mixing colors together to see what new colors we can create. We will measure distance from one object to another.

Craft and Writing – We will begin the week with a cute giraffe craft. The children have been working really hard on name printing. We will roll up our sleeves for some finger painting fun this week. St. Patrick's Play-Doh mats will be added to the fine motor art shelves.

Motor: Now that the weather appears to be getting nicer (fingers crossed!) we plan on bringing motor activities outdoors as much as possible, so please dress your child appropriately. The children will learn a new relay game called "Mr. Fox What Time Is It?".
