LANGUAGE ARTS: Mrs. Nina has a lot of *Farm* songs and finger plays to teach the children over the next two weeks. Keep your ears open, maybe you can hear your child singing them. The words to "I'm A Little Chick" are below to help you identify one as they sing around the house.

CRAFT & WRITING: Our *Farm* theme and letter Ee will be reinforced through several readiness papers. A cow will be painted *brown*, a hen will be painted in watercolors, *pink* crayons will be used to color a pig, and cotton balls will be glued to a sheep. Tactile experiences are enhanced through the use of shaving cream and play-doh.

CONCEPT: Over the next two weeks we will be quite busy with all the chores that farmers do. Letters Aa- Ee will be reinforced. Then there is finding small, medium and large chickens.

MOTOR: Oh, the fun that will be had over the next two weeks! We'll start out pretending to be farm animals, so watch out for a chicken or cow on the loose. We will also go bowling – farm animal bowling! Eye/foot coordination is developed through an activity which has the children kicking a ball at a target. An exercise CD is always enjoyed as the children pretend to be animals.
