Concept: In addition to counting to 50, Mrs. Ann's class concept class will continue counting by 2's and 5's and reviewing odd and even numbers. Language Arts: We begin the week discussing the various types of farms, such as crop farming. We will explore the different animals, equipment and crops found at different types of farms.
