Introduce: Aa

Language Arts: This week our picture file will be filled with all kinds of zoo animals. We'll learn some new flannel board stories, "Going to the Zoo" and "Brown Bear Brown Bear". We will also learn some new finger plays. Here is one about an alligator for you to enjoy with your child.
