Theme: Transportation
Weeks of 1/30 & 2/6



Concept: Planes, trains, and automobiles will be the topic for the next two weeks. We'll sort through transportation vehicles and decide if they belong in the air, sea, or on land. In the water table we'll play with boats, and play a seriation game with cars.

Language Arts: We will listen to and sing songs about transportation. What better way to start off our week than singing one of our favorite songs, "The Wheels on the Bus," and learning a new song, "When I Get Into the Car." We'll also read a story we love called *Down by the Station*. We will learn a new flannel board story, "Where Does This Go?," and a finger play, "I'm A Little Airplane."

Art: We will be coloring, painting and mosaicing our favorite types of transportation. Look for boats, trucks, trains and bicycles. We'll have lots of fun dragging our cars through shaving cream and seeing the tracks they leave behind.

Motor: We will use bean bags to throw on different colored circles and will introduce actions to our new words come and go. Stoplight bean bag toss will help reinforce our theme. The stairsteps will be used as a boat and we'll sing "Row Row Row Your Boat." We'll finish the week with an obstacle course which will include the balance beam and the tunnel.
