Language Arts: Bugs! Bugs! Bugs! Mrs. Mary's classroom will go positively buggy learning about insects this week. The children will learn that insects are cold blooded creatures that have three main body parts, six legs, and a skeleton on the outside of their bodies. Library selections for the week will include the books "Hey Little Ant" and "Charlie the Caterpillar." We will also count bugs into jars-who will fill theirs first? and insect races.
