Craft & Writing:

Over the next two weeks we will be working on number, letter and name tracing papers. We will also be practicing our scissor skills and we will be coloring and painting papers that will reinforce our theme. For some sensory and fine motor fun we will be playing with shaving cream and play-doh.

Concept:

The letters Cc and Dd are added to the shelves for the children to work on. The children will learn about tally marks to graph things and we will also work on positional words like in, out, under, above and behind. All these concepts will be worked on for the next few weeks.

Motor:

While outside, the children will enjoy rolling down the hill like Jack and Jill along with having a Humpty Dumpty race. As we plan to go outside for several activities this week, please be sure your child has the appropriate clothing for the up-coming weather.
