Language Arts

Our focus for the next few weeks will be our new letters. We will begin playing "Build a Word" with the letters introduced so far this year. The students will learn about the "at" family. We will also play the "Build a Sentence" game, in which we make a sentence using sight words.

Craft and Writing

Printing of our new letters and working on phonics papers related to these letters will keep us busy this week. The children will create an apple craft with tissue paper and some cute fall crafts to decorate our classroom.

Math & Science

The children will continue to review numbers 1-20. AB patterns and geometric shapes ellipsoid and ovoid will be introduced. The children will learn to compose and decompose numbers in relation to 5 & 10, using a ten frame.

In Science, the children will learn about apples. They will taste different kinds of apples, do an apple experiment, talk about the similarities and differences of apples, and graph our favorite color of apples. Our new season, **Fall** and the changes taking place will be discussed.
