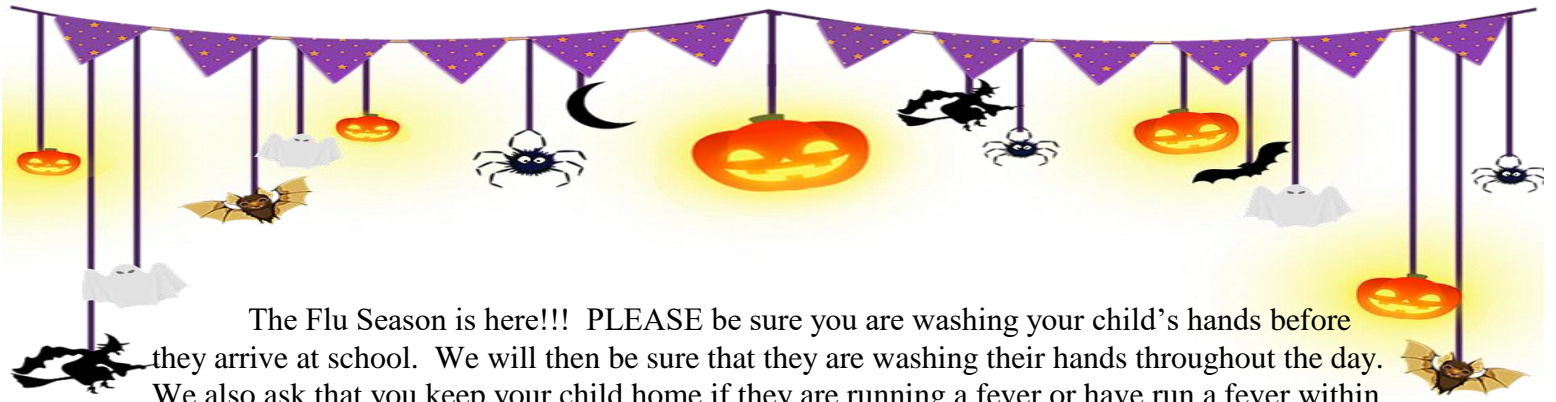

The Flu Season is here!!! PLEASE be sure you are washing your child's hands before they arrive at school. We will then be sure that they are washing their hands throughout the day. We also ask that you keep your child home if they are running a fever or have run a fever within the last 24 hours. If your child has a persistent cough or runny nose, vomiting or diarrhea PLEASE keep them home. We try to keep our school as germ free as possible and we must have your help. We disinfect and clean our school daily, so please do your part. Thank You!

**PARENTS—WE NEED YOUR HELP!!!!** We would like to ask that all parents follow their drop off and pick up times that they registered for. Our staff schedules are determined by this and when a child arrives earlier or stays later it affects our ratios. If you are in need of earlier or later times please stop by the office. We will always try to accommodate your needs. If you are unsure of what hours you registered for PLEASE see the office. Thank you for your attention to this matter!

As always, our goal here at Bobbie Noonan's is to provide an environment where every child feels safe, secure, and loved. We want every child to experience success. Parents we ask your help by trying to have your child here by 9:00. We know that things come up occasionally where this may not always be possible. However, when your child is arriving later than 9:00 it makes it very difficult for the teachers to give your child the attention he/she deserves. When working with young children it is very difficult to have them wait or have the class interrupted once it has begun. The beginning of our preschool program is very important to any child. This time is spent reviewing and reinforcing what has already been taught to them.

We also ask that you do not let your child bring toys, money or backpacks to school. Please help us by leaving these items at home or in the car. Your child's teacher will let you know when there will be a scheduled show-n-tell day or may ask you to bring in something for a special project.

We would like to remind all parents that our school closes promptly at 6:00. Any child who is left here after this time will be charged a late fee. This fee needs to be paid directly to the closing teacher. The fee is \$6.00 for every 15 minutes beginning with the first 5 minutes. If you have any questions regarding this matter please stop by the office.

Please do not send your child with breakfast unless it can be eaten BEFORE 7:15A.M. Children begin arriving at this time and start changing classrooms. Please be sure that your child's breakfast follows our all-natural food policy. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. If at any time you have questions or concerns please do not hesitate to stop by or call the office.

The Health Nurse will be coming in to check your child's school medical records. Every



child needs to have an up-to-date copy of their immunizations and physical forms. If you have received a letter stating you are in need of either or both forms please return by the due date posted. If you can not get an appointment by the due date please bring in an appointment card for your child's file. Any child who is out of compliance will not be allowed to attend school until the forms are completed. There will be no exceptions made. Thank You!

Please remember that tuition is due the first day of the week that your child attends. If they are a pre-school student tuition is due the first of every month. Any tuition that is not paid by Friday morning will be considered late and a fee of \$10.00 will be added to your account. Please try to make arrangements so that your account stays current. If an emergency arises please let us know.

Bobbie Noonan's will be celebrating Halloween on Tuesday, October 31st from 9:00-12:00. All children may come wearing their costume attire. If your child is a full day student please be sure to have your child wear their costumes OVER their clothes. We also ask that you bring a bag to put their costumes in. All-natural snacks will also be welcomed on this day. Keep an eye out for more information.
