Language:

This week for our theme of Pets we will learn finger plays and listen to stories. The children may bring in a picture of their pet, if your child does not have a pet they may bring a picture of a pet they would like to have. We will introduce the letters Ee and Ff this week, along with their phonetic sounds.

Our first story, "Taffy Apple," will also be reviewed this week. Watch for their stories to come home! The children will be able to bring home their story as soon as they can read it on their own.

Show-n-Tell will be on Friday this week. Please bring in <u>ONE</u> item that begins with the letter Ee and <u>ONE</u> item that begins with the letter Ff. Remember both Show-n-Tell items must fit into a gallon zip lock bag that is labeled with your child's name.

Concept:

This week the children will be introduced to the numbers 3 and 4 and our new shapes, circle and square. Our group activity is going to be "can you tell me?" With this activity I will line up 5 different objects, the children will close their eyes, one object will be taken away and the children will need to tell me which one is missing. We will also participate in a Science activity where we will see which object will fit into a specific size cup.

Craft & Writing:

This week the children will be working on a variety of tracing papers to help reinforce the letters Ee and Ff, along with the numbers 3 and 4. We will also have a following directions paper to reinforce the shapes circle and square. The children will enjoy working on projects that go along with our theme, as well as working on printing our names and enhancing our cutting skills.

Motor:

The children will be doing an activity where they will race while they crawl along a path. If the weather permits, we will be going outside. Please remember that if your child wears sandals to school they NEED to have gym shoes to play on the equipment.
