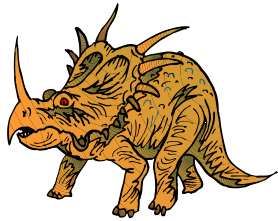


Pre K Press

Introductions

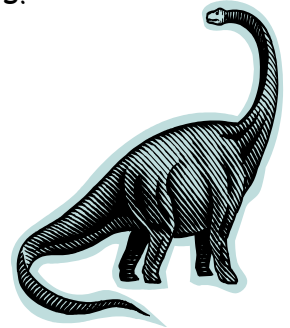
Letters: *Gg, Hh*
