INTRODUCING: 13 & 14

LANGUAGE:

We are going to prepare for Halloween by role playing what to do and say when we go trick or treating. We have flannel board stories, books and songs about Halloween to enjoy.

We are working on earning reading stories. We practice every day reading and learning the sight words.

The children also sing 'A' is for Amos daily to help reinforce phonetic sounds.

CONCEPT:

We received all the pumpkins from Charli's Gigi that are by the front door to examine, compare and contrast. Lastly, we will cut into a pumpkin and learn the parts of it.

Also, remember the first letter to a name is upper case and the rest is lower case. We have Halloween crafts and projects to complete and we may play with orange and black play dough with Halloween cookie cutters.
