THEME: Animals in the Winter

This week we will learn about Winter Animals. Animals that hibernate, migrate, and stay active during the winter.

The children will begin doing their work independently. Any papers involving new concepts will be done together with the class.

Craft and Writing

The children will begin printing first and last names, letters, words and sentences on lined paper. Journal writing will also begin this week.

Math

In Math, the children will learn to tell and write time by the hour. They will learn how to recognize greater/less than and equal numbers as well as simple fractions, including $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{5}$, $\frac{1}{6}$.

Language Arts

The children will be introduced to "diagraphs". Diagraphs are two letters that together make one sound, such as ch, sh, th, wh and ph.

The children will also be learning about "CVC" words. Consonant-Vowel-Consonant words.
