<u>Math</u>

In Math, the children will learn to tell and write time by the hour. They will learn how to recognize greater/less than and equal numbers as well as simple fractions, including $\frac{1}{2}$, 1/3, $\frac{1}{4}$, 1/5, 1/6.

<u>Language Arts</u>

The children will be introduced to "diagraphs". Diagraphs are two letters that together make one sound, such as ch, sh, th, wh and ph.

The children will also be learning about "CVC" words. Consonant-Vowel-Consonant words.
