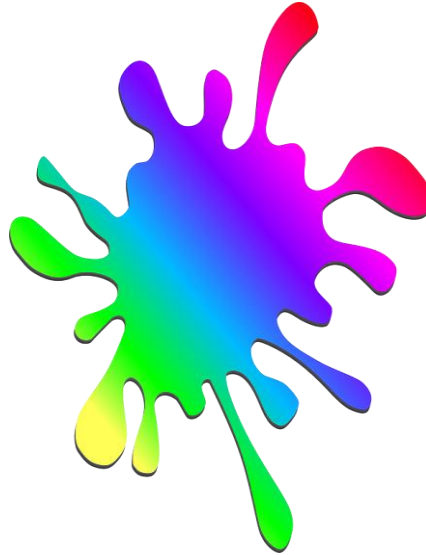
Bits of Intelligence: Musical Instruments

Language Arts

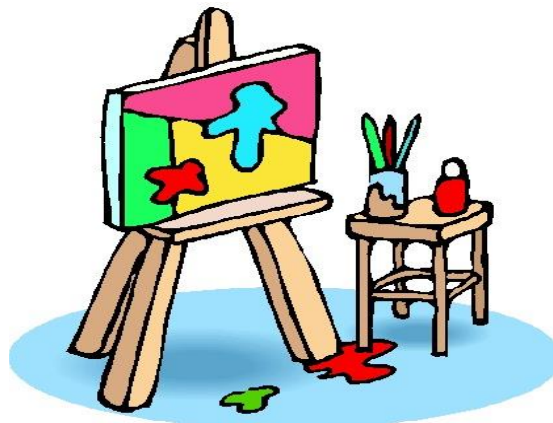
