Theme: Plants and Gardening

Introductions:

Letters– Ww, and Xx



Language Arts: Let's explore the garden and see what we can find! Flowers, trees, grass, dirt, and seeds will be explored. Our class will discuss the parts of a flower and learn about what it needs to grow. We will look closely at picture files of colorful flowers, nature, and gardening. We will focus on new vocabulary words throughout the next two weeks and read a variety of books about plants. The new letters Ww and Xx will be discussed and reviewed when we sing about our phonetic sounds.

Craft and Writing: Our little gardeners are busy at work preparing special gifts for Mother's Day! As we learn about this theme, we will use our creative skills to decorate a special flower craft. Our new letters Ww and Xx will be introduced in our craft papers. We will learn to trace these new letters as well as collage them.

Concept: What makes the flowers grow? The class will put together our parts of the plant puzzle as we locate these parts: roots, stem, and flowers. Flowers will also be used for small, medium, and large seriation, as well as in the estimation jar and sensory bins.

Motor: The weather is soon starting to get warmer! The children will start to spend more time doing outdoor play. We will continue to work on our large motor skills by practicing hopping, skipping, and jumping.
