Flowers

There will be no new introductions this week.

We will review all that we have learned this year.

LANGUAGE AND READING:

Our class is going to explore the theme of flowers and gardening. The flowers and trees outside are beginning to bloom! The children are going to learn what a garden is by viewing pictures and looking around outside. We will teach them that a garden can grow fruits, vegetables, plants and many beautiful flowers. We will sing songs about the rain and sun (two things that make things grow).

CONCEPT:

The children and I will once again go on a scavenger hunt outside to explore what plants, trees and flowers grow around Bobbie Noonan's. We will distinguish the difference between fruits and vegetables by playing a sorting game. The children will get to plant their own seeds. We will learn the parts of a flower and enjoy a flower experiment.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

We are going to get creative this week! The children are going to create their very own gardens. We have a flower craft to do and we are going to make some bugs that we find in a garden.
