Theme:
Red, White and Boom

The next 2 weeks we will be focusing on our patriotic theme and learning some patriotic fun facts. Let's wear red, white and blue each day to show our patriotic spirit. We will also work on patriotic art projects throughout the week. If you have any patriotic books you may bring them in to share. Please remember to label with your child's name.

Science:

Some of the science experiments that we will be doing are fireworks in a Jar and baking soda and vinegar fireworks and peppermint fireworks. For our peppermint experiment we will be using a plate, a peppermint candy and room temperature water.

For our fireworks in a Jar we will be using red and blue food coloring, oil and warm water to create our own fireworks. For our baking soda and vinegar fireworks we will be using baking soda, vinegar, star cookie cutters, red, blue and silver glitter and a small syringe. Let's see what kind of fireworks we create

Language:

The next two weeks we will be reading patriotic themed books. Please help us by bringing in books to go along with our theme. We will also be singing patriotic songs, we will play 4th of July bingo, and play I-Spy.

Motor:

For the next 2 weeks we will be playing patriotic motor games, patriotic yoga, we will fish for numbers, we will go on a patriotic scavenger hunt, a balloon game and 4th of July ring toss. To wrap up our theme, the kids will toss bean bags through a hoop and will play a red, white and blue star hopscotch.

Thursday: Math

We will be counting colored stars and graph the colors and how many we count.

Art:

The next 2 weeks we will be using the colors red, white and blue to make our patriotic art projects. These will include making lanterns, a 4th of July hat, red, white and blue night fireworks, 4th of July music shakers, USA hand prints and we will color the American Flag.

Theme Papers:

We will be drawing a line to the matching patriotic picture and figure out what comes next.
