Theme: Wild, Wild West

Science:

Cactus Sponge Experiment

Did you know that a fully-grown Saguaro cactus can soak up and store up to 200 gallons of water during a good downpour? And they can store water until the next rainfall. For our experiment we will use sponges cut out in the shape of a cactus, we then will add them to a cup with a little water and watch what happens.

Marshmallows in a vacuum

Let's see what will happen when we put large marshmallows in a vacuum sealer container and remove all the air from the container.

Dancing Corn

We will be using corn kernels, vinegar and baking soda for this experiment.

Slime

The kids will be mixing ingredients to make sand slime.

Art:

Cactus Art

The kids will be painting their very own cactus and glue toothpicks on for the cactus spines. We will also make a handprint cactus and a horse. The kids will also be making cowboy & cowgirl hats, sheriff badges and they will be making their own wanted poster with their picture on it.

Theme Papers:

Our theme papers will be working on will be tracing wild, wild west words, an I Spy paper as well as a letter lasso paper.

Language:

The next two weeks we will be reading wild, wild west themed books. If you have any books that go along with our theme, please bring them in to share during class. Also, please remember to label the book with your child's name. We will also be playing letter bingo, letter fishing, singing wild, wild west songs and we will learn a poem called "I'm a Little Cowboy".

Motor:

For the next two weeks we will have fun pretending to be cowboys and cowgirls. We will have pony races, go through an obstacle course while riding our ponies along with trying to lasso our ponies using hula hoops. We will also have a roll & poke activity and a cowboy ring toss.
