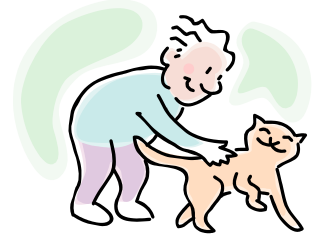




Pre K Press
